Handball: A group of KS2 children will be taking part in a Handball Competition at OWS on Tuesday.

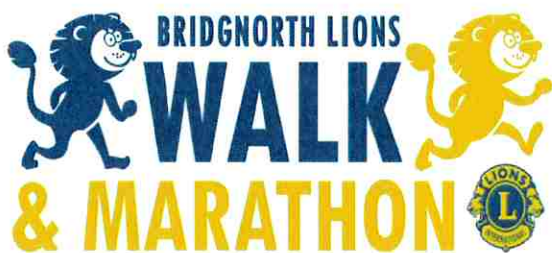
Friday Sports Club : A reminder that there will be no Friday Night Sports Club as Mr Carter will be away on the residential with Year 6.
