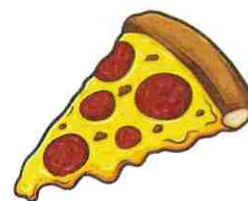
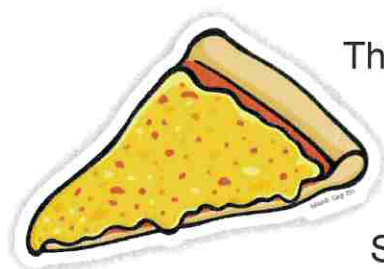
Pizza Monday
