



For the PTA to continue, we need a new committee chair/chairs.


If you're interested in taking over or finding out more, please contact either the PTA or the school office as soon as possible.

Each Bingo book costs £5.

You can buy them on your ticket slip or from our volunteers before the game starts.

Each book contains multiple Bingo cards for different rounds.

Keep your book safe—each page is used for a new game!

Once you have your book, grab a marker or dabber, and get ready to play.

We will also have dabbers for sale!

OTHER QUESTIONS WE GET ASKED ...

· Can Children attend?

YES! Plus after some feedback from KS1, we have even changed from our usual Friday evening, to a Saturday afternoon to allow KS1 children with earlier bedtimes to attend!

· Does everyone attending have to play?

No, people can attend and simply help their children. However you will still have to pay the 50p per person ticket price. It's also important to remember this is a charity fundraiser, so the more bingo players, the better our total raised!

· Can I share?
