

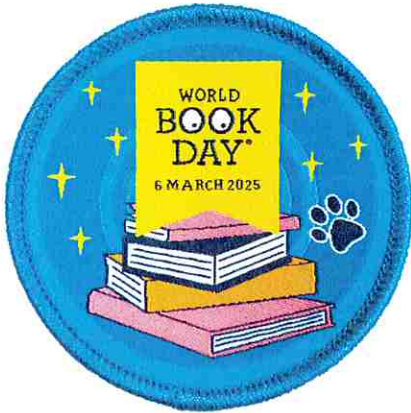

Athletics and Orienteering

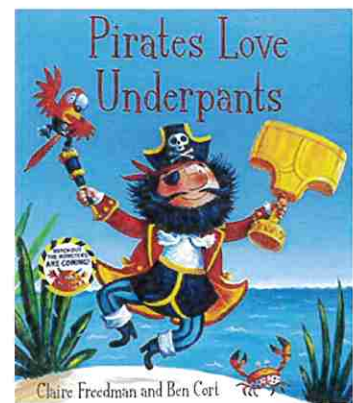
