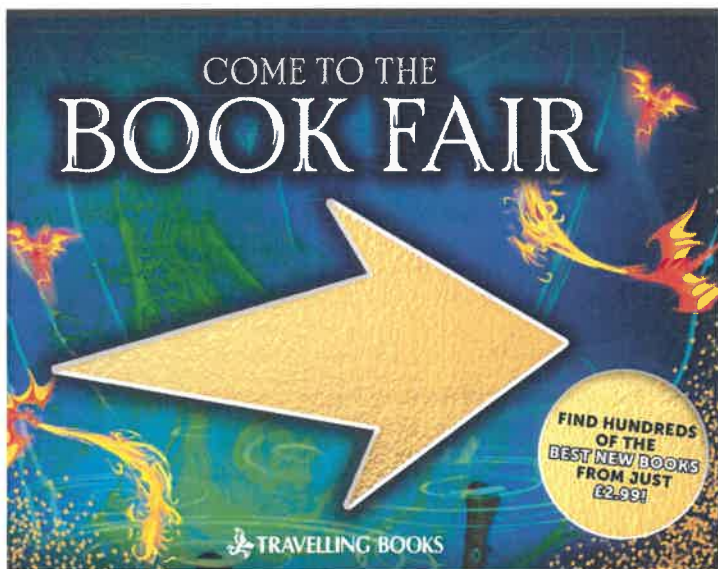
Shrewsbury Museum
