However, as these will be made off site, should you wish to order one for your child, this will need to be pre-ordered using the form/QR code below. THE DEADLINE FOR ORDERS IS MONDAY 10TH JULY AT 10.00 AM. Unfortunately, no school dinners will be able to be provided during the last week of term unless pre-ordered by Monday 10th July.
