### **Happy New Year**

It was lovely to welcome you back to school on Wednesday this week. I know many of you had a tricky time walking to school on the icy pavements. We now understand that Castlefields Road and Conduit Lane are no longer on the gritting route, so please exercise caution when driving or walking on icy or snowy days. I am in contact with the council and I am trying to rectify the situation.

#### **Covid Cases**

As you are well aware the local Covid rate remains high. Where possible, Lateral Flow Tests should be done twice weekly. If your child has symptoms, no matter how mild, they should get a PCR test. Lateral Flow tests do not always work once you are symptomatic.

If there are positive cases in your child's class, I post a message on ClassDojo and alert you to that using our text messaging service. In these cases, your child is considered a close contact and it is strongly advised that they take a Lateral Flow Test daily.
