












PTA news and AGM

Passes for walking across the field from Oldbury Wells

Oldbury Gates are open from 8.00 am to 8.55 am and from 3.00 pm - 4.30 pm which are the times that pass holders have permission to cross the site via the pedestrian entrance. The stipulated route must be used - under the bridge, across the playground and up the designated path (not across the field). Children are not permitted to ride bikes/scooters or similar on the premises and dogs are not allowed. Without a pass, it is likely that you will not be allowed access.

If you currently hold a pass, please check that it is in date. If you require a pass, please contact the school office. This also includes any grandparents, childminders, carers etc that may bring/collect your child.
