Walking Bus

As you are aware, Shropshire Council will soon be implementing a School Streets Programme which will include Castlefields. At this stage, School only has only received the same information as parents. As this will affect how children travel to school, we would like implement a Walking Bus. We used to run a very successful Walking Bus (starting at Wenlock Rise) and with enough new parent volunteer support, we can do it again!

What is a walking bus?

An environmentally friendly and safe way of travelling to school. Children walk to school in group supervised by trained adults.

How to be a volunteer walking bus operator?

We need parent volunteers to help operate the walking bus. If you think you could help (it might be just one morning a week) please contact the office staff or the Headteacher. Ray Hughes, the Shropshire Council's school travel officer will join us for the Try Out walk. You will need a DBS and a quick training session at the school with Ray.

How do children join?

For children to join the official walking bus a consent form will need to be completed. There is no charge and you will be playing a part in helping tackle the congestion issue whilst allowing your child to reap the valuable exercise and road safety benefits of using this service.


Circus: There are a few remaining tickets for the 4pm Circus showing and food is still available to be pre-ordered.


Tickets prices will increase and be advertised externally from next Thursday.
